- Developing & adapting solutions for LMICs

Weaknesses

- Ageing system
- Partnerships beyond the network
- Complex governance
- Content vs. methodology
- Tensions between public good & enterprise approaches

Opportunities

- Focus on solutions for LMICs – differentiation
- Initiating change (not responding to it)
- Interoperability & integration of other systems
- Increase international position

Threats

- Other solutions/system (competitive field)
- Immediacy & mobility
- Speed / momentum of change
- Lack of resources & standstill

Focus

- "Learning organization" as integral to corporate strategy
- International expansion – globalization of VHL
- Tighten focus on innovation & solutions for LMICs
- Outreach
- Highlight expertise in methodology (as much as the system)
- Further innovate (i.e. mobility & pervasiveness)
